The venue can easily be reached from the Frankfurt Main Train Station (Hauptbahnhof) or from Willy-Brandt-Platz.

Public Transportation: If you are taking public transportation you can either walk up Kaiserstraße from the Frankfurt Main Train Station or walk over from Willy-Brandt-Platz where there is a U-Bahn station.

By Car: If you are coming by car, it is best to use the new car-park „Theaterparkhaus“ near Willy-Brandt-Platz which has all night parking after 6PM for only 3 euros. Other car-parks are located at the Hauptbahnhof, Kaiserplatz and Parkhaus Fürstenhof / Dresdner Bank.
